## Laurie Krauz

Laurie Krauz thrills audiences with her award-winning, blues-influenced jazz vocals and her powerful emotional range. She has performed with a number of jazz luminaries including George Coleman, Harold Mabern, Cameron Brown, Warren Vaché and Mark Murphy, and has appeared at such legendary New York City venues as The Blue Note, Iridium, Birdland and Town Hall. Her debut CD, *CATCH ME IF YOU CAN* (LML Music), has received accolades throughout the music world, and recently, Laurie was named one of the 500 top jazz vocalists of all time in a book by noted jazz critic, Scott Yanow (tentatively entitled *The Jazz Singers/Backbeat Books*, 2005).

Laurie has appeared as a singer on *The Cosby Show*; on *Good Night Blue*, a CD released by the TV program *Blues Clues*; and in numerous musical theatre productions throughout the U.S. including *Man of La Mancha (Aldonza)* and *Show Boat (Julie)*.



## Sue Matsuki

Sue Matsuki is a multi award-winning jazz/cabaret vocalist who has literally played nearly every club in New York including the legendary Village Gate; Iridium; and Town Hall as well as 88's; Arci's Place; and Caroline's Comedy Club. She has also appeared at The Gardenia Room in Los Angeles; the Fairbanks Summer Arts Festival in Alaska; and The Four Seasons in Las Vegas. Sue was named a “Best of Connecticut” by The Connecticut Magazine and Foxwood's Casino. Her debut CD, *A New Take*, was nominated for the 2002 MAC Award for Female Recording of the Year and has been receiving air play across the country and internationally.

Sue has appeared in and choreographed productions of *Oklahoma*; *Bye, Bye Birdie*; *A Christmas Carol*; *Agnes of God*; *West Side Story*; and *They're Playing Our Song* and has been featured in the Metropolitan Opera's productions of *Moses und Aaron*; *Tristan und Isolde*; *Norma*; and *Il Travatore*.
